

# 666

## **The Image of the Beast and the Number of His Name.**

*Revelations 13:17* And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.

*18* Here is wisdom. Let him that hath understanding count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number is Six hundred threescore and six.

**In the Old Testament, we find a statue in the image of a man. This image represents the four great dictators, which were the four beast powers, starting with Nebuchadnezzar; the King of Babylon.**

*Daniel 7:3* And four great beasts came up from the sea, diverse one from another.

**The other dictator states represented in this statue were the The Medes, Persians, Greeks and the Roman Empire.**

*Daniel 2: 31* Thou, O king, sawest, and behold a great image. This great image, whose brightness was excellent, stood before thee; and the form thereof was terrible.

*32* This image's head was of fine gold, his breast and his arms of silver, his

*belly and his thighs of brass,*

*33 His legs of iron, his feet part of iron and part of clay.*

*34 Thou sawest till that a stone was cut out without hands, which smote the image upon his feet that were of iron and clay, and brake them to pieces.*

*35 Then was the iron, the clay, the brass, the silver, and the gold, broken to pieces together, and became like the chaff of the summer threshing floors; and the wind carried them away, that no place was found for them: and the stone that smote the image became a great mountain, and filled the whole earth.*

**The number 666 represents only one of these leaders; the dictator of the Roman Empire. This dictatorship of 666 will end the rule of man because 666 is the number of man.**

**The next empire will be the 7<sup>th</sup>, a divine kingdom, the number of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.**

**The number seven represents the 7<sup>th</sup> day sabbath.**

*Genesis 2:1 -3. 1 Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them.*

*2 And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made.*

*3 And God blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God created and made.*

**Understand that the beast power is going to be angry with sabbath keepers. The beast wants them to take his mark instead of the 7<sup>th</sup> day sabbath.**

**The Bible tells us that the seventh day sabbath is a sign between God and His people.**

*Ezekiel 20:12 Moreover also I gave them my sabbaths, to be a sign between me and them, that they might know that I am the LORD that sanctify them.*

**This beast power wants sabbath keepers to remove that sign and take on his sign, the number of his name, 666.**

**The beast power is going to require that no one be allowed to “Judanize” by keeping the 7<sup>th</sup> day sabbath. If they want to buy or sell, they must take his mark 666 on their forehead or their hand.**

**Those that keep Sunday will be able to buy or sell. The religious leader that rides the beast made Sunday the day of worship according to the written doctrine of the Catholic Church. The New Saint Joseph Baltimore Catechism Lesson 18 on page 86 says :**

Sunday is our day of worship

Our Lord gave the Apostles power to change the Lord's day from Saturday to Sunday. The Apostles did this because on Sunday Our Lord rose from the dead. And it was Sunday that the Holy Ghost came upon the Apostles.

On Sunday we worship God by taking part in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. We should also spend more time thinking about God on this day.

**There's no place in the Bible where Jesus or the Father**

**told the apostles to change the 7<sup>th</sup> day sabbath to Sunday. This is a false statement made by the Catholic Church.**

**The resurrection was not on a Sunday but on the end of the 7<sup>th</sup> day Sabbath before the sun went down, which was a Saturday and not Sunday. Jesus was not crucified on so called "Good Friday." He was crucified on a Wednesday.**

**Remember, the Pharisees asked Jesus for a sign because they heard Him say that He would destroy the temple in three days and build it again.**

**They wanted to know what He meant by this statement.**

*Matthew 12:38 Then certain of the scribes and of the Pharisees answered, saying, Master, we would see a sign from thee.*

*39But he answered and said unto them, An evil and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given to it, but the sign of the prophet Jonas:*

*40For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.*

**In order for Jesus to be in the earth three days and three nights He could not have been crucified on a Friday. It would not give Him enough time to fulfill the prophecy of Jonah. He would not be the real Messiah. So He had to be crucified on a day of the week that would give Him enough time to fulfill 72 hours. Also the Bible**

**says. in** *Daniel 9:26. That the Messiah shall be cut off in the midst of the week.*

**A week has seven days starting with Sunday as the 1<sup>st</sup> day.**

**Monday is the 2<sup>nd</sup> day.**

**Tuesday is the 3<sup>rd</sup> day.**

**Wednesday which is the 4<sup>th</sup> day, gave Jesus time to spend the three days left in the grave: those days being Thursday, Friday and Saturday.**

**They crucified and buried Him before the sun went down on Wednesday. Therefore on Saturday, at the same time they buried Him on Wednesday, before the Sun went down, he was resurrected fulfilling the prophesy of Jonah.**

*Matthew 12:40 For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.*

**Scripture can not be broken. Events must happen like they are prophesied lest He could not be the Messiah.**

**The Jewish passover was going on during the time of the crucifixion. That Wednesday was the preparation day for killing the Passover Lamb. The following day was the *high sabbath* of the Feast of Unleavened Bread. Whenever the word *preparation day* is used, this indicates that the next day is going to be a high sabbath.**

**The preparation day during the crucifixion of Jesus Christ was on a Wednesday. Most Christians believe it was a Friday because they have been taught that Friday is the preparation day for the 7<sup>th</sup> day sabbath.**

**That is not true.**

**Everyday of the week is a preparation day for the 7<sup>th</sup> day Sabbath.**

**But the preparation day for the feast, is always the day before the feast which is usually a high sabbath.**

*John 19:14 And it was the preparation of the passover, and about the sixth hour: and he saith unto the Jews, Behold your King!*

*John 19:31 The Jews therefore, because it was the preparation, that the bodies should not remain upon the cross on the sabbath day, (for that sabbath day was an high day,) besought Pilate that their legs might be broken, and that they might be taken away.*

**The statement made in the Baltimore Catechism, that the Holy Ghost fell upon the apostles on a Sunday was a true statement. However, there is no scripture supporting the statement where God told the apostles to change the 7<sup>th</sup> sabbath day to Sunday. This was a false statement that can't be found in any Bible, not even the Catholic Bible.**

## **The Name of the Beast**

**The name of the Beast will be the name that represents**

## **the dictator's location.**

According to some sources, both the Hebrew and Greek names of Romulus, the legendary founder and first king of Rome, add up to 666. This, to some indicates that everyone called "Roman" has the "name" of the man for whom Rome was named.

**Remember, all dictators require their subjects to hold their name in great honor. That's why in Germany, the term "Hiel Hitler" is a statement of respect. Mussolini and the modern day Saddam Hussein have statues and pictures of themselves everywhere in their country.**

**This modern day dictator beast power will have an image of himself for people to worship. With modern technology, he will be able to speak through the beast and attract attention throughout the earth.**

*Revelations 13:15 And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.*

**In some parts of the world, people assemble to pray at the sound of an instrument heard throughout the country.**

**This will get people's attention because the beast power wants to be worshiped as a deity. Remember, he will sit in the temple of God as god requiring all to worship him.**

*2 Thessalonians 2:4 Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God.*

*5 Remember ye not, that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things?  
6 And now ye know what withholdeth that he might be revealed in his time.*

**Even King Nebuchadnezzar made an image of himself and required the Hebrew boys to worship his image or be cast into a furnace that was heated 7 times hotter.**

*Daniel 3:19 Then Nebuchadnezzar was furious with Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, and his attitude toward them changed. He ordered the furnace heated seven times hotter than usual*

*20 and commanded some of the strongest soldiers in his army to tie up Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego and throw them into the blazing furnace.*

*21 So these men, wearing their robes, trousers, turbans and other clothes, were bound and thrown into the blazing furnace.*

*22 The king's command was so urgent and the furnace so hot that the flames of the fire killed the soldiers who took up Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego,*

*23 and these three men, firmly tied, fell into the blazing furnace.*

**This beast power and his religious leader will adopt the same philosophy we see in the churches today that are filled with statues and images to worship such as: So called Mary the “Mother of Jesus” the so called “patron saints” and crucifixes of a so called European looking**

**“Jesus”. This will be nothing out of the ordinary for them to see the image of the beast.**

**God has told true Christians not to make any images.**

*Exodus 20:1 And God spoke all these words:*

*2 "I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.*

*3 "You shall have no other gods before <sup>[a]</sup> me.*

*"You shall not make for yourself an idol in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below.*

*5 You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the fathers to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me,*

**Those that keep the commandments of God will not be able to bow down to this image and because so, they will not be able to buy or sale.**

**All the nations of the earth have been deceived by satan the devil. The Bible says he deceived the whole world.**

*Revelations 12:9 And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.*

**Remember, there are ministers who are deceived and are deceiving others without realizing it.**

*2 Timothy 2:13 But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived.*

**That's why God is going to send an angel who will warn people not to take the mark of the beast exposing satan who deceived the whole world.**

*Revelations 14:9 And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand,*

*10 The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:*

#### DANIEL CHAPTER 2

*1 And in the second year of the reign of Nebuchadnezzar Nebuchadnezzar dreamed dreams, wherewith his spirit was troubled, and his sleep brake from him.*

*2 Then the king commanded to call the magicians, and the astrologers, and the sorcerers, and the Chaldeans, for to shew the king his dreams. So they came and stood before the king.*

*3 And the king said unto them, I have dreamed a dream, and my spirit was troubled to know the dream.*

*4 Then spake the Chaldeans to the king in Syriack, O king, live for ever: tell thy servants the dream, and we will shew the interpretation.*

*5 The king answered and said to the Chaldeans, The thing is gone from me: if ye will not make known unto me the dream, with the interpretation thereof, ye shall be cut in pieces, and your houses shall be made a dunghill.*

*6 But if ye shew the dream, and the interpretation thereof, ye shall receive of me gifts and rewards and great honour: therefore shew me the dream, and the interpretation thereof.*

*7 They answered again and said, Let the king tell his servants the dream, and we will shew the interpretation of it.*

*8 The king answered and said, I know of certainty that ye would gain the time, because ye see the thing is gone from me.*

*9 But if ye will not make known unto me the dream, there is but one decree for you: for ye have prepared lying and corrupt words to speak before me, till the time be changed: therefore tell me the dream, and I shall know that ye can shew me the interpretation thereof.*

*10 The Chaldeans answered before the king, and said, There is not a man upon the earth that can shew the king's matter: therefore there is no king, lord, nor ruler, that asked such things at any magician, or astrologer, or Chaldean.*

*11 And it is a rare thing that the king requireth, and there is none other that can shew it before the king, except the gods, whose dwelling is not with flesh.*

*12 For this cause the king was angry and very furious, and commanded to destroy all the wise men of Babylon.*

*13And the decree went forth that the wise men should be slain; and they sought Daniel and his fellows to be slain.*

*14Then Daniel answered with counsel and wisdom to Arioch the captain of the king's guard, which was gone forth to slay the wise men of Babylon:*

*15He answered and said to Arioch the king's captain, Why is the decree so hasty from the king? Then Arioch made the thing known to Daniel.*

*16Then Daniel went in, and desired of the king that he would give him time, and that he would shew the king the interpretation.*

*17Then Daniel went to his house, and made the thing known to Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah, his companions:*

*18That they would desire mercies of the God of heaven concerning this secret; that Daniel and his fellows should not perish with the rest of the wise men of Babylon.*

*19Then was the secret revealed unto Daniel in a night vision. Then Daniel blessed the God of heaven.*

*20Daniel answered and said, Blessed be the name of God for ever and ever: for wisdom and might are his:*

*21And he changeth the times and the seasons: he removeth kings, and setteth up kings: he giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding:*

*22He revealeth the deep and secret things: he knoweth what is in the darkness, and the light dwelleth with him.*

*23I thank thee, and praise thee, O thou God of my fathers, who hast given me wisdom and might, and hast made known unto me now what we desired of thee: for thou hast now made known unto us the king's matter.*

*24Therefore Daniel went in unto Arioch, whom the king had ordained to destroy the wise men of Babylon: he went and said thus unto him; Destroy not the wise men of Babylon: bring me in before the king, and I will shew unto the king the interpretation.*

*25Then Arioch brought in Daniel before the king in haste, and said thus unto him, I have found a man of the captives of Judah, that will make known unto the king the interpretation.*

*26The king answered and said to Daniel, whose name was Belteshazzar, Art thou able to make known unto me the dream which I have seen, and the interpretation thereof?*

*27Daniel answered in the presence of the king, and said, The secret which the king hath demanded cannot the wise men, the astrologers, the magicians, the soothsayers, shew unto the king;*

*28But there is a God in heaven that revealeth secrets, and maketh known to the king Nebuchadnezzar what shall be in the latter days. Thy dream, and the visions of thy head upon thy bed, are these;*

*29As for thee, O king, thy thoughts came into thy mind upon thy bed, what should come to pass hereafter: and he that revealeth secrets maketh known to thee what shall come to pass.*

*30But as for me, this secret is not revealed to me for any wisdom that I have more than any living, but for their sakes that shall make known the interpretation to the king, and that thou mightest know the thoughts of thy heart.*

*31Thou, O king, sawest, and behold a great image. This great image, whose brightness was excellent, stood before thee; and the form thereof was terrible.*

*32This image's head was of fine gold, his breast and his arms of silver, his belly and his thighs of brass,*

*33His legs of iron, his feet part of iron and part of clay.*

*34Thou sawest till that a stone was cut out without hands, which smote the image upon his feet that were of iron and clay, and brake them to pieces.*

*35Then was the iron, the clay, the brass, the silver, and the gold, broken to pieces together, and became like the chaff of the summer threshingfloors; and the wind carried them away, that no place was found for them: and the stone that smote the image became a great mountain, and filled the whole earth.*

*36This is the dream; and we will tell the interpretation thereof before the king.*

*37Thou, O king, art a king of kings: for the God of heaven hath given thee a kingdom, power, and strength, and glory.*

*38And wheresoever the children of men dwell, the beasts of the field and the fowls of the heaven hath he given into thine hand, and hath made thee ruler over them all. Thou art this head of gold.*

*39And after thee shall arise another kingdom inferior to thee, and another third kingdom of brass, which shall bear rule over all the earth.*

*40And the fourth kingdom shall be strong as iron: forasmuch as iron breaketh in pieces and subdueth all things: and as iron that breaketh all these, shall it break in pieces and bruise.*

*41And whereas thou sawest the feet and toes, part of potters' clay, and part of iron, the kingdom shall be divided; but there shall be in it of the strength of the iron, forasmuch as thou sawest the iron mixed with miry clay.*

*42And as the toes of the feet were part of iron, and part of clay, so the kingdom shall be partly strong, and partly broken.*

*43And whereas thou sawest iron mixed with miry clay, they shall mingle themselves with the seed of men: but they shall not cleave one to another, even as iron is not mixed with clay.*

*44And in the days of these kings shall the God of heaven set up a kingdom, which shall never be destroyed: and the kingdom shall not be left to other people, but it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand for ever.*

*45Forasmuch as thou sawest that the stone was cut out of the mountain without hands, and that it brake in pieces the iron, the brass, the clay, the silver, and the gold; the great God hath made known to the king what shall come to pass hereafter: and the dream is certain, and the interpretation thereof sure.*

*46Then the king Nebuchadnezzar fell upon his face, and worshipped Daniel, and commanded that they should offer an oblation and sweet odours unto him.*

*47The king answered unto Daniel, and said, Of a truth it is, that your God is a God of gods, and a Lord of kings, and a revealer of secrets, seeing thou couldst reveal this secret.*

*48Then the king made Daniel a great man, and gave him many great gifts, and made him ruler over the whole province of Babylon, and chief of the governors over all the wise men of Babylon.*

*49Then Daniel requested of the king, and he set Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, over the affairs of the province of Babylon: but Daniel sat in the gate of the king.*
