

## **HOW MANY ARE THERE IN THE GODHEAD?**

**The purpose of this book is to show the Christian world that God is not a trinity but a family in which you can be born into if you can overcome satan's devices.**

**Ephesians 3: 14** For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,

**15** Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named,

**Remember the word trinity is not in the bible. It was added into Christian history by the Roman Catholic Church at the Nicene Council in 325 A.D.**

**The doctrine of the trinity eliminates Christians from becoming members of the God family. This doctrine tries to make Yahweh who is a true and living God, three distinct gods in one.**

**People use bits and pieces of scripture to prove the trinity doctrine. The scriptures they use do not support this doctrine. The main scripture they use is Matthew 28:19:**

**Matthew 28:19** Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

**We must understand who the Father is. The Father is Yahweh. The Son, which we call Jesus, who is Yahshua, He came in His Father's Name.**

**John 5:43** I am come in my Father's name, and ye receive me not: if another shall come in his own name, him ye will receive.

**The family name is Yahweh. The Holy Spirit is the spirit of Yahweh. The Holy Spirit makes Yahweh, who is the Father, and Yashua who is the Son, omnipotent. The word omnipotent means they can be, through the spirit, throughout the entire universe including planet earth, at the same time. The spirit is also their presence, which is called, the Holy Ghost.**

**When Matthew 28:19 says baptize in the Name of the Father, Son and Holy Ghost this is showing us that we should be baptized in the family name.**

**Remember God is a family as we stated in the book of Ephesians 3:14-15.**

**In Genesis 1:1, the text reads in the Hebrew; “In the beginning was Elohim.”**

**Elohim is a plural noun which means more than one such as a team, or a group. That is the reason God said in Genesis 1:26 let *us* make man in *our* image, after *our* likeness. This shows that there were two in the Godhead and not three. He didn't say let us make man in the image of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost. He said let us make man in *our* image because the Holy Ghost has no human image.**

**That's why Jesus said, "It is written in the law that the in mouth of *two* witnesses let every word be established." This included creation. Jesus said that He was one, and His Father was one. This makes *two* showing there are only two family members in the Godhead at this present time.**

**John 8: 17** It is also written in your law, that the testimony of two men is true.

**18** I am one that bear witness of myself, and the Father that sent me beareth witness of me.

**19** Then said they unto him, Where is thy Father? Jesus answered, Ye neither know me, nor my Father: if ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also.

**We saints are potential members of God's family also. That's why the bible says that we are joint heirs with Jesus Christ.**

**Romans 8:17** And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.

**John 1:1 says "In the beginning was the Word." This one that was called the Word was the Logos in the Greek. He was with the one called God which was the Theos in the Greek, who is Yahweh. The one called the Word was the one that became flesh.**

**John 1:14** And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

**In the Old Testament the Logos was the God that Israel served. That's the reason Moses said "Hear oh Israel, the Lord our God is one." Understand that Moses was only talking about the Logos. He was not talking about the Theos who is the Father. He was talking about the Logos, who Israel called God. They did not know the other deity in the Godhead who was the Father, the Theos.**

**That's why Jesus said "You have never heard His voice or saw His shape at any time".**

**John 5:37** And the Father himself, which hath sent me, hath borne witness of me. Ye have neither heard his voice at any time, nor seen his shape.

**The one who was the Logos, who Israel worshipped, was always being compared with the idols that Israel made out of wood and stone. He said to Israel in Isaiah 44:17 "they took the residue of a tree, and made a god and bowed themselves down to it."**

**The Logos who was the God that Israel served, had to always remind them that He alone by Himself created all things. The Logos was not saying there was no other member in the Godhead besides Himself, but He was**

**telling them that no God made out of any material thing could be compared to Him.**

**Isaiah 44:24** Thus saith the LORD, thy redeemer, and he that formed thee from the womb, I am the LORD that maketh all things; that stretcheth forth the heavens alone; that spreadeth abroad the earth by myself;

**Someone may ask, if the Logos created all things by Himself, how would the Theos, who is the Father, be involved in creation and how is He apart of the Godhead?**

**Remember the bible says in the book of Colossians 1:14-19, that the father let Jesus, who in the Old Testament was the Logos, create all things that the Father wanted to be created.**

**Colossians 1:14** In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:

**15** Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature:

**16** For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:

**17** And he is before all things, and by him all things consist.

**18** And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence.

**19** For it pleased the Father that in him should all fulness dwell;

**One who believes in the trinity doctrine may ask “What part does the Holy Spirit play in the Godhead?”**

**Understand that the Holy Spirit is the means the two members of the Godhead use to be ever present. They send forth the spirit and things are created.**

**Psalms 104:30** Thou sendest forth thy spirit, they are created: and thou renewest the face of the earth.

**In the Old Testament, Israel only knew the Word who was called Yahweh in the Hebrew language; who was called the Logos in the Greek language.**

**Once the one called the Word became flesh according John 1:14, He had to manifest that there was someone else in the Godhead besides Himself that still had control of the universe.**

**That’s why Jesus said to the man who called Him “Good Master.” “Why call me good, there is only one good and that’s the Father”. He also said, “My Father is greater than I”.**

**At that particular time, Jesus was no longer a member of the divine family of Yahweh. He had become a member of the human family.**

**The apostle Paul wrote in Philippians 2:5-7 that Jesus gave up being a member of the God family to become a member of the human family.**

**Philippians 2:5** Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

**6** Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:

**7** But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:

**Once Jesus became a member of the human family, He was able to die for the sins of mankind redeeming us back to God. That's the reason Jesus said to the Father, after He finished the work God gave Him to do, "Give me back what I had with thee before the world was."**

**What Jesus wanted back was the His divinity and immortality so He could become a member of the God family again.**

**John 17: 5** And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was.

**Remember the lamb, which was a type of Jesus Christ, was slain from the foundation of the world.**

**Revelation 13:8** And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

**Also remember that the Word, who was the Logos in the Old Testament, Israel's God, said prepare me a body so I can come down in the volume of the book.**

**Psalms 40:7** Then said I, Lo, I come: in the volume of the book it is written of me,

**Jesus said to the Jews in the New Testament, "I'm the manna that came down from heaven and whosoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood shall have eternal life in Him".**

**John 6:54** Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day.

**55** For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed.

**56** He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him.

**57** As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father: so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me.

**58** This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever.

**This shows that Jesus had a place in the Godhead before He came to earth. Clearly there are two members in the Godhead.**

**The trinity doctrine can not be proven in the bible. The bible shows us that there are two members in the Godhead. One called the father, who is Yahweh, and the one called the Word, who is also Yahweh because Yahweh is the family name.**

**For example: a family name could be Jones. But there is more than one person in a family because Jones can't be a family with only one member; Robert Jones and Johnny Jones are two distinct persons with one family name.**

**That's how it is with the family of God. The apostle Paul said "I bow my knee unto the family of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ for whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named." We here are on the earth can become family members in God's family. Right now, we are potential family members if we can finish the work that God has put in us by overcoming the world, the flesh and the devil.**

**We will be born again into the family of Yahweh. Right now, there is only one born again member in the family and that is Jesus Christ.**

**1 Corinthians 15:20** But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept.

**Colossians 1:18** And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence.

**The trinity doctrine stops any other members from being added to the family of God. No three in one can be a family.**

**The Jesus only doctrine stops any other members from being added to the family of God because no one person can be a family. The Jesus only doctrine teaches that there is only one being in the Godhead. They teach that this one being manifests Himself in three distinct attributes. On one hand He's a God, then He's a human being, next He's the Holy Spirit in the Church.**

**If God manifest Himself as a mortal human being, how can He become a God again if there's no one but Himself? You need to think about this and see if you can find any scriptures that support these doctrines.**

**The trinity doctrine teaches that there are three distinct persons in the Godhead. We have showed you clearly in the scriptures that there are two in the Godhead who have the image like a man because they said let us make man in *our* image.**

**We have searched the bible and found no image of a man for the Holy Spirit. We found the image of the dove and**

**water but we have found no body form of a man for the Holy Spirit.**

**We have not seen the Holy Spirit sitting at the left hand of the Father. However, the bible tells us that Jesus sits at God's right hand. Stephen looked straight into heaven and saw Jesus sitting at the right hand of the Father.**

**Acts 7:55** But he, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God,

**How can the Holy Spirit be a distinct person with no body? This is a false concept and cannot not be found anywhere in the scriptures. It's the imagination of men who do not understand that the Godhead is a family.**

**Take your time, read the book of John and you will see that it's only the Father and the Son. John said that whosoever has the Father has the Son also further showing that there are two members in the Godhead. One God and one Lord. The one God is Yahweh the Father. The one Lord is Jesus Christ the Word.**
